JACQUELINE MOSCICKE

Jacqueline Moscicke grew up in Sussex, Wisconsin. She started her training at the age of five at To The Pointe Dance Studio. She continued her training at Milwaukee Ballet School on full scholarship under the direction of Bobby Ball and Rolando Yanes. Her most influential teacher there was Jeanette Makaroff. Moscicke is a graduate of the Milwaukee Ballet II program and was hired into the Milwaukee Ballet Company in 2005. Moscicke was also in



William Shatner's documentary Gonzo Ballet choreographed by Margo Sappington while at Milwaukee Ballet.

In 2009, Moscicke joined the Joffrey Ballet. While at the Joffrey, Moscicke danced many roles in ballets including William Forsythe's In the Middle, Somewhat Elevated; Gerald Arpino's Viva Vivaldi; Antony Tudor's Lilac Garden; Christopher Wheeldon's Swan Lake; and Yuri Possokhov's Bells. In 2018, her last show with the Joffrey Ballet was in Paris, dancing Jerome Robbins' Glass Pieces. Moscicke is currently dancing and teaching master classes across the country as a freelance artist. She has also created her own dancewear line called MSeam Apparel.

CHRISTOPHER LINGNER

Chris Lingner began his career joining the 2009 National Tour of Twyla Tharp's Moving Out, dancing the principal roles of Eddie and James, making him one of the youngest performers to ever dance these roles. Lingner has been a Principal guest artist with Midwest Repertory Ballet, Gregory Hancock Dance Theatre, Indianapolis School of Ballet, New Albany Ballet, Peoria Ballet, in



the Young Stars of Ballet Gala, presented by Indianapolis City Ballet, Ballet Virginia, Dayton Ballet, and Chamber Dance Project in Washington D.C. In 2012, Sonya Tayeh created a new work on him for an NFL Super Bowl-Super Cure event fighting breast cancer.

Lingner studied ballet in the Jacobs School of Music at Indiana University where he danced principal roles in works by Twyla Tharp, George Balanchine, Paul Taylor, Dwight Rhoden, August Bournonville, Josh Bergasse, Antony Tudor, Nicolo Fonte, and Peter Martins. Lingner later joined Cincinnati Ballet where he has performed in works by Adam Hougland, Victoria Morgan, Trey McIntyre, Septime Webre, Viktor Plotnikov, Jessica Lang, Jennifer Archibald, Annabelle Lopez Ochoa, Yuri Possokhov, Ohad Naharin, and Kirk Peterson. Lingner also toured with Cincinnati Ballet to The Joyce Theatre in NYC and the Kennedy Center. Musical Theatre credits include, Hairspray (Oasis of the Seas), Guys and Dolls (Flatrock Play House), and Jerome Robbins Broadway (The MUNY). As a producer, Lingner was nominated for a Tony Award as a Co-Producer for Broadway's "On the Town" and "Best Show of 2016" for his production of the first Ballet Royalty Gala in Havana, Cuba which was live streamed to 30 countries.

Lingner also helped found Indianapolis Ballet as an original company member where he danced many leading roles by Founding Artistic Director, Victoria Lyras, George Balanchine, Scott Jovovich, and Ramon Flowers. Lingner comes courtesy of Indiana Ballet Conservatory where he now works as their Business Operations Manager.
